BILLECART SALMON

BRUT ROSE

BLEND OF CHARDONNAY, PINOT MEUNIER AND PINOT NOIR

A romantic champagne. This cuvée provides a reference point amongst rosé champagnes. Sparkling color, it's amazing finesse and its great intensity. **Aroma:** Subtle and fine aromas, leading to a gourmand seduction of red berry flavors and citrus zest with an aromatic burst of great finesse which is both floral and refreshing.

Palate: An outstanding tactile sensation with a creamy smoothness, which evolves into a very noble notion with a character of wild strawberries and a slightly raspberry finish. A harmonious and delicious equilibrium with a remarkable precision.

Tasting: Best paired with a fillet of wild salmon or a carpaccio of langoustines. In terms of desserts, it will enhance the flavors of red fruits with an acidic crunch and only lightly sweetened.



BRUT RESERVE

30% PINOT NOIR, 30% CHARDONNAY, 40% PINOT MEUNIER

Harmony and balance. The Brut Reserve is a light, fine and harmonious champagne. It is made up of a blend from three different years and sourced from the best sites in the Champagne region.

Aroma: A distinct and precise intensity with an ethereal character, followed by a natural and radiant freshness. With the presence of a perfect primary example (floral and fresh fruits), highlighted by a volatility of very pure and lightly biscuit aromas.

Palate: A subtle pleasure with a delicate texture under the charm of white flesh fruit flavors (apples, crunchy pears). With a beautiful fluidity of a delicious lightness uniting gourmand flavors of springtime.

Tasting: The ideal partner for every occasion. It is perfect as an aperitif and can be enjoyed with a wide variety of dishes.



BLANC DE BLANCS GRAND CRU

100% CHARDONNAY

Villages de la Côte des Blancs. Delicacy and elegance. This cuvée is a blend of two different years. Its complexity, its great vinosity and the surprisingly fresh finish is particularly appreciated by informed wine lovers.

Aroma: A very pure and mineral intensity with an uncommon typicity, releasing notes of brioche, fresh butter and lemony citrus fruits. A distinguished and subtle realm that delicately evolves with a remarkable finesse.

Palate: A creamy sensation with a chalky and meringue texture, associated with nuances of fresh almonds and citron zest. A smoothness of great class which is chiseled and persistent.

Tasting: An exceptional fermentation with a chalky, mineral style which wonderfully accompanies Ossetra caviar or fine marinated sashimi.



BRUT NATURE

30% PINOT NOIR, 30% CHARDONNAY, 40% PINOT MEUNIER

Pure and Refined. It's full of brightness and purity.

Aroma: It's the engagement of an authentic seduction, nuanced by the purity and the exact maturity of a distinct and vibrant aromatic profile (orchard fruits, fresh citrus and small pains au lait).

Palate: An ample and harmonious tactile approach, preserved by a deliciously chiseled mineral tension. A well balanced and nicely rounded light sparkling sensation is strengthened by a captivating gustatory trajectory (white flesh fruits, lime trees and almond cream).

Tasting: A new definition of a refined style, it will surprise you in its complicity with the finest food: a veal carpaccio, grilled scallops and citrus marinated sashimi.

BRUT SOUS BOIS

3 CHAMPENOIS GRAPE VARIETIES

Captivating and Original. This unique cuvée is entirely vinified in oak. It totally masters the art of blending by renewing the ancestral spirit and savoir-faire of the original champagnes.

Appearance: golden glints brought to life by a luminous stream of persistent, fine bubbles.

Aromas: There is a rich olfactory impact which is harmoniously expressed (dried fruits, fresh citrus and white flesh fruits) and coupled with finely buttered seductive notes.

Palate: A burst of flavors (notes of grilled brioche and toffee) thanks to the distinguished power and maturity which is a mark of any great wine of Champagne.

Tasting: Its strength of character and integrity make it an ideal accompaniment to poultry dishes or Girolle mushrooms.



CLOS SAINT-HILAIRE

BLANC DE NOIRS CUVÉE

Rarity and complexity. This unique Blanc de Noirs cuvée bears the name of the patron saint of Mareuil-sur-Ay. This one hectare los adheres to strict standards: a single, enclosed, undivided plot of land, with a complete winemaking facility on site. This astonishingly characteristic single-variety Champagne has all the qualities expected of a truly great, deep, unique vin de garde.



CUVÉE ELISABETH SALMON 2008

76% GRANDS CRUS AND 24% PREMIERS CRUS
55% PINOT NOIR | 45% CHARDONNAY |
9% PINOT NOIR

Depth & Complexity. Created in 1988 as a tribute to Elisabeth Salmon, one of the House's founders, set apart by its radiance, refined purity as well as unique character.

Aroma: A refreshing and sensual sensory expression of citrus peels and red berry jelly, with the exquisite sensation of a rich and complex aromatic amplitude (Plougastel strawberry, Mara des Bois and vine peach). Beautifully refined and mature olfactory notes, releasing a distinctive perfume of scented soft spices and wild raspberry pulp.

Palate: Harmonious blossoming of gourmet flavors (tangerine, blood orange and Reinette apple tart). A fullbodied and layer mouthfeel, evolving towards a chalky edge and a lingering finish of citron zest and red and white currants.

Tasting: This great wine is endowed with great finesse and delicacy, its personality shining through textures and flavors. An aromatic charm coupled with a rare mineral dimension, ideally paired with poulet de Bresse or Breton langoustines royales.



CUVÉE LOUIS SALMON 2007

100% CHARDONNAY

Purity and mineralogy. Named in tribute to Louis, Elisabeth Salmon's brother, who was passionate about oenology and highly involved. Originating from the best parcels of the Côte des Blancs.

Aroma: An elegant complexity mineral, floral and yellow flesh fruits (bergamot, white flowers and fresh pineapple). It displays an aromatic profile with an incredibly pure chalky character.

Palate: There is a creamy, tactile sensation on the palate with a graceful finesse and a beautifully refreshing balance with natural flavors (citron zest, wild peaches and white pepper). This wine is powerful, accentuating an aromatic persistence with a long and majestic finish.

Tasting: its great potential and its balance revealing a remarkable, dignified finesse worthy of the most beautiful gustatory matches: whole Corrèze sweetbreads en cocotte or a creamy shellfish risotto.

30% PINOT NOIR | 30%
CHARDONNAY | 40% PINOT

Sweetness and Sensuality. Has an identical blend to the Brut Reserve. It maintains the same finesse and elegance as this cuvée but with a greater dosage.

Appearance: It has a beautiful, pale gold color emitting a constant procession of fine, regular and persistent bubbles in the glass.

Aroma: On the nose it is lively with a hint of delicate white flowers which evolve towards aromas of buttered brioche.

Palate: This Demi-Sec champagne is full-flavored and is a reference for its perfect balance between sugar, alcohol and acidity.

Tasting: Ideal when served with patisseries or chocolate cake; it also turns a brioche afternoon snack into a unique experience.



VINTAGE 2009

40% PINOT NOIR | 33% CHARDONNAY
| 27% PINOT MEUNIER

Intense and Seductive. An ideal blend allowing the personality of the Champagne region's great Pinot Noirs to dominate combined with the elegance and subtlety of Chardonnays and the signature touch of Pinot Meunier.

Aromas: The delicious intensity of precise fruit with citrusy and nutty notes (grapefruit pulp, slivered almonds). A nuanced sensory development built around pastry scents (raw butter, white fruit jelly). A masterful aromatic expression with a refined, refreshing purity.

Palate: A nervy, charming, tactile delight (chestnut cream, fresh blueberries and shortbread), emphasized by a delicate texture. The wine rises to a distinguished complexity with a persistent finale, crisply structured by the high-quality potential of such a sought-after vintage.

Tasting: A deeply sculpted vintage with a noble, exquisitely distinctive character. Enjoy to the fullest with red tuna, papaya and avocado, or with pan-fried foie gras, peaches, verbena, rhubarb and verjuice (prematurely harvested grape juice).



SAINT CLAIRE CHABLIS

100% CHARDONNAY
The Sainte Claire Chablis expresses with a great deal of finesse the typicity of its Chablis soil: the Kimmeridgian. Made from Chardonnay grapes, this vintage expresses the singularity of our wines through its strength, precision and freshness. On the nose, notes of lemon, yellow fruits. The mouth is wrapped, balanced, and tangy. A specific wine while gluttony. Serve with shellfish, salmon, tuna, solegateau net for pears, vanilla cream.



BOURGOGNE KIMMERIDGIEN

CHAMBLIS CHARDONNAY
Pure soil of Chablis, Kimmeridgian is alternate layers of very compact limestone, and softer clayey marls containing marine fossilized bodies Jean-Marc Brocard created this Geologic Chardonnay Collection to allow every soil to reveal its personality and its authenticity through Chardonnay.
Tasting Notes:
An citrus notes on nose with orange blossom. A very pure palate, with mandarin aromas which gives him all the delicacy. A fresh wine with a very beautiful mineral energy.

PRIMARY CHABLIS

The Domaine Jean-Marc Brocard is a big name in Chablis. We would like to give you a first glance of our style. Note lemon, white peach, yellow fruit. The palate is round and greedy. A specific wine and round. Serve with oysters, seafood, grilled fish, light-to-medium-flavoured courses.

PETIT CHABLIS



FRUITY CHABLIS

The Petit Chablis takes its roots in Portland soil which is essentially made up of limestone. This appellation is the fruitiest of the Chablis wines, it is a fresh and pleasurable wine. Yellow colour with green reflection, lime notes, grapefruit, passion fruit. A gourmet wine, energetic with good persistence. Serve with seafood and oysters.

VIEILLES VIGNES



70 YEAR OLD VINES

Epitomizing the domaine, the Vieilles Vignes de Jean-Marc Brocard (Jean-Marc Brocard's Old Vines) were planted around 70 year ago. Their roots reach down over 25 meters into Kimmeridgian soil. The wines, which are more concentrated, express all the complexity and finesse of the Chardonnay grape. Nose of anise, pink grapefruit, lemon, salt, persistent and crisp. The palate is balanced, beautiful energy. Serve with mushroom pie, quiches, shellfish, fish, rabbit with mustard, dry goat cheese.

GRAND CRU BLANCHOTS



POWERFUL WINE

The Grand Cru Blancchots takes root on a very steep slope, catching the early morning sun (Southeastern exposure): a unique characteristic which results in a powerful wine with an equally unique attack on the palate. A very mineral style in the end of mouth. A beautifully harmonious wine. Buttered, toasted, salt, final salivating, floral, fine wine, good density and persistence in the mouth. Serve with fish, seafood and shellfish, grilled or in a cream sauce. Poultry and white meat, grilled or in a cream sauce.

GRAND CRU BOUGROS



CHABLIS WITH CHARACTER

Implanted at the leftmost West/Southwestern end of the Grands Crus, the Grand Cru Bougros shows great strength of character and will go wonderfully well with your fish dishes.

Nose: Oyster shell, spicy, bark orange

In the mouth: fine minerality, mandarin aroma. An energizing and digestible wine

Serve with fish, seafood and shellfish, grilled or in a cream sauce. Poultry and white meat, grilled or in a cream sauce.

GRAND CRU GRENOUILLES



SMALLEST PARCEL

This parcel is the smallest of the Grand Crus (23.67 acres in total), and faces Southwest. The personality of this terroir is very complex and its wines are voluptuous, tender and delicate once they age a little.

In the mouth, the wine is truly harmonious, very well-balanced, remarkable for its pure elegance and finesse, with an unbelievably long mineral finish. The pallet of aromas is extremely wide, changing with the weather and the seasons.

Serve with fish, seafood and shellfish, grilled or in a cream sauce. Poultry and white meat, grilled or in a cream sauce.

GRAND CRU LE CLOS



THE CRADEL OF CHABLIS

Les Clos, which is the cradle of Chablis vineyards, is the largest of the Grands Crus. Due to its open Southern exposure, this terroir yields generous wines, which are full bodied and with a very long finish. Lemony, vanilla, salt. Nice texture, is characterized by its smoothness with elegance.

Serve with fish, seafood and shellfish, grilled or in a cream sauce. Poultry and white meat, grilled or in a cream sauce.

GRAND CRU LES PERUSES



VOLUPTUOUS WINE

The terroir of the Chablis Grand Cru Les Preuses is markedly shaped like an amphitheatre. The sub-soil offers a harmonious combination of compact clay and calcareous soils.

From Les Preuses one reaps elegance and voluptuousness whilst savouring a finish full of finesse.

Floral notes on the nose, with fruit driven hints enhanced by intense mineral notes and lightly smoky touches. Very rounded on the palate, but also full-bodied yet elegant.

Serve with fish, seafood and shellfish, grilled or in a cream sauce. Poultry and white meat, grilled or in a cream sauce.

GRAND CRU VALMUR



SURPRISING FRUITINESS

The Chablis Grand Cru Valmur forms a valley which offers subtle variations in terms of exposure: one part faces Northwest and the other the South. With a well-balanced mineral character, the Valmur is imposing through its strength and surprising fruitiness. Lemony nose, peppery at spicy, toasted notes and iodine, is stretched across the mouth of liquorice, chopped and brioche. Serve with fish, seafood and shellfish, grilled or in a cream sauce. Poultry and white meat, grilled or in a cream sauce.

GRAND CRU VAUDESIR



DELICATE

Out of all the Chablis Grands Crus, the Vaudésir is the most delicate. It will charm you with its lively yet elegant character. The slopes of the Vaudésir valley are steep and express a particularly fine minerality.

Fresh, elegant aromas of flowers and fruit. On the palate, it is distinguished from other Grands Crus by its own particular subtlety: a delicious blend of softness and liveliness. Light yet rounded, it shows great charm from a very early age.

Serve with fish, seafood and shellfish, grilled or in a cream sauce. Poultry and white meat, grilled or in a cream sauce.

PREMIER CRU BUTTEAUX



STRUCTURED AND FLORAL

A deeper and more clayey terroir which is significantly exposed to heat in the summer, the Butteaux yields concentrated wines which are structured and very floral, with elegance and strength making them wines which are very representative of their appellation.

A toasted wine, grain of salt notes. On the palate, notes of toasted hazelnut, iodized. A beautiful finesse. Served with fish, seafood and shellfish, grilled or in a cream sauce. Poultry and white meat, grilled or in a cream sauce.

PREMIER CRU FOURCHAUME



MINERAL WINE

Downstream of the Serein, the river which runs through the Chablis vineyards, the Fourchaume terroir has a richer soil than the rest of the vineyard, due to the alluvial soils which are washed by the river. This makes for more flattering, pleasant and supple wines that still carry the mineral quality of the Chablis. Golden green. Fresh nose with toasted notes.

In the mouth: saline notes, mineral and candied lemon aromas.

A refined and elegant wine. Serve with fish, seafood and shellfish, grilled or in a cream sauce. Poultry and white meat, grilled or in a cream sauce.

PREMIER CRU MONTEE DE TONNERRE



MOST COMPLETE CHABLIS

Sitting to the right of the Grands Crus valley, the Chablis Premier Cru Montée de Tonnerre is without a doubt the most complete of the Premiers Crus: it concentrates minerality, a floral touch and richness into a great vin de garde... it's for keeps.

Aromas of crystallized apricot, underlying butter and liquorice notes, with touches of spices (white pepper). Lovely minerality, with a powerful and a structured finish. Serve with fish, seafood and shellfish, grilled or in a cream sauce. Poultry and white meat, grilled or in a cream sauce.

PREMIER CRU MONTMAINS



DENSE & LEMONY

It is on the left bank of the Serein River, which runs through the Chablis vineyards, that the Premier Cru Montmains has taken root. This wide slope provides the wines with a mineral character which blends in beautifully with floral aromas. White gold colour with green reflection.

Nose: hints of citrus, grapefruit and anise. The mouth is salt, chopped, dense, lemony and refreshing with a nice length. Serve with fish, seafood and shellfish, grilled or in a cream sauce. Poultry and white meat, grilled or in a cream sauce.

PREMIER CRU VAU DE VEY



CLEAR AND PRECISE

The Premier Cru Vau de Vey vines cling on to a very steep slope. Located on the left bank of the Serein River and facing East, this terroir gives us rich and delicate wines with a marked minerality.

Gold-green colour. A clear and precise wine, salt and flexible, anise. Finish is soft and warm.

Serve with fish, seafood and shellfish, grilled or in a cream sauce. Poultry and white meat, grilled or in a cream sauce.

PREMIER CRU VAUCOUPIN



POWERFUL AND RICH

Located around the village of Chichée, these vines are protected from climatic hazards thanks to their position. The terroir is made of complex Kimmeridgian soil which confers a powerful minerality yet is delicate on the palate.

The nose is generous with a beautiful aromatic richness. Fruity, floral and honey aromas make this Premier Cru a powerful and elegant wine.

Serve with fish, seafood and shellfish, grilled or in a cream sauce. Poultry and white meat, grilled or in a cream sauce.

JEAN MARC BROCARD/ BOUCHARD AINE

PREMIER CRU VAULORENT



FRESH AND LIGHT

The Vaurorent is one of the vineyards' best known Premiers crus. It sits next to the Grand Cru Les Preuses which it resembles in some of its qualities. It is a refined wine which carries wonderful energy. The attack is fresh and light; giving an impression of purity. The palate is light; characterized by notes of subtle richness.

Serve with fish, seafood and shellfish, grilled or in a cream sauce. Poultry and white meat, grilled or in a cream sauce.

BEAUJOLAIS-VILLAGES



100% GAMAY

Visual: bright and limpid red crimson

Nose: straightforward and expressive, fruity and floral

Palate: elegant and racy. Fresh and lively, yet persistent

This wine was made to be enjoyed on every occasion. It pairs perfectly with delicatessen meats, poultry in creamy sauce or a barbecue for instance

BEAUNE PREMIER CRU "CLOS DU ROI"



100% PINOT NOIR

For its full-bodied structure and powerful aromas, this wine pairs perfectly with game meats or aged soft cheeses such as Epoisses, Soumaintrain or Maroilles. The Terroir de Bourgogne range is a selection of reputed single vineyards Villages, Premier and Grand Crus from Côte de Nuits and Côte de Beaune principally. They are produced in very limited quantities, as a sign of the special care we put into their production. This "village" appellation takes its name from the town of Beaune.

FIXIN "LA MAZIÈRE"



100% PINOT NOIR

Fixin is always described as a very masculine wine for its powerful structure and firm tannins. The Terroirs de Bourgogne range is a selection of reputed villages, Premier and Grand Crus from Côte de Nuits and Côte de Beaune principally.

These wines are produced in very limited quantities and every step from harvesting to ageing is mastered by our winemaker.

Fixin is a Côte de Nuits appellation which takes its name from the village of Fixin, nestled at the entry of the combe north of Gevrey-Chambertin.

This village appellation spreads over 100 hectares, of which 19 are classified as Premiers Crus, with only 4% producing white wines.

BOUCHARD AINE

MÂCON-VILLAGES



100% CHARDONNAY

Colour: A pale gold with green tints, brilliant and clear.

Nose: Flowery, fruity aromas with notes of citrus fruits, mint and honeysuckle. Exotic, even spicy scents.

Palate: Well-balanced. The dominant notes are reminiscent of grass and flowers. In general Mâcon-Villages wines are dry, light, lively, charming and fresh. Their spontaneity and lightness make them very seductive. Ideal with hors d'oeuvres, snails, frogs' legs, freshwater fish stew, mussels, fish, chitterling sausages and goats' milk cheeses.

MEURSAULT PREMIER CRU "LE PORUSOT"



100% CHARDONNAY

Serve and enjoy with delicate fish (perch with a creamy sauce) or white meats, poultry, grilled lobster, crayfish, gambas, blue cheeses and foie gras!

The Terroir de Bourgogne range is a selection of reputed single vineyards Villages, Premier and Grand Crus from Côte de Nuits and Côte de Beaune principally. They are produced in very limited quantities, as a sign of the special care we put into their production.

This village appellation from the Côte de Beaune, marks along with Puligny-Montrachet and Meursault one tip of the Golden Triangle. This area produces one of the most famous white wines in Burgundy, which represent about 2/3 of the total production. Meursault takes its name from the village of Meursault. The vineyards extend over 396 hectares of which 96% produce white wine and 27% are ranked as Premier Cru.

HERITAGE DU CONSEILLER PINOT NOIR



100% PINOT NOIR

Colour: bright red garnet

Nose: delicate aromas of cherry and coffee with subtly integrated toasted notes

Palate: the mouth is appealing and fruity with delicate toasted notes and a medium body. Flavours of chocolate are emphasized by a hint of menthol, lying on silky tannins. The finish is long with assorted fruit flavours and a subtle touch of oak. The perfect match for all meats, barbecues, pizzas and assorted vegetables.

SAINT-VERAN "LA GRANDE BRUYÈRE"



100% CHARDONNAY

Visual: Greeny-gold.

Nose : While young it has aromas of white fruits (peaches, pears), white and yellow flowers (acacia and honeysuckle, scotch broom). As it ages it becomes reminiscent of hazelnuts, grilled almonds, honey and gun-flint.

Palate: A dry wine which is also round, soft and fruity. Ideal as an aperitif, with hors-d'oeuvres, delicate cooked meats, oysters, shellfish and fish.

BOUCHARD AINE

SAVIGNY-LES-BEAUNE



100% PINOT NOIR

Excellent with red or white meat dishes, but try avoiding strongly-flavoured sauces as these would conceal its fine, subtle structure. A Côte de Beaune appellation which takes its name from the village of Savigny-lès-Beaune and produces almost only red wines (90% of production). The Savigny-lès-Beaune appellation covers 383 hectares, 144 of them being classified as Premier Cru. The vineyard spreads in a "V" shape along the Rhoin alluvial fan. So there are many different terroirs there, from ferrous stony soils near Pernand-Vergelesses to more clayey soils with red-brownish limestones when going down the slope or even sandy soils on the other hillside. From this diversity arise the so typical fruitiness and suppleness of Savigny-les-Beaune wines.

BOURGOGNE CHARDONNAY 2019



100% CHARDONNAY

Colour: Pale gold with green reflects.

Bouquet: Expressive nose with notes of citrus and white flowers.

Palate: A dry, mineral wine that first develops aromas of citrus, then notes of gunflint and white flowers. Very aromatic with a pure and nice persistency.

A perfect choice for aperitifs, starters and tapas, cold cuts, seafood and grilled fish.

A regional appellation grown throughout the wine-growing area of Burgundy.

The Bourgogne blanc appellation covers approximately 1000 hectares. Throughout the wine-growing area, there are multiple terroirs which allow a wide range of aromas in the wines.

Our white Bourgogne is mainly made of Chardonnay grapes harvested on selected terroirs in the south of Burgundy: in the Maconnais area and Côte Chalonnaise. A small part of our cuvée is also coming from the Côte de Beaune vineyards. This is where our viniculturist plays a very important role in the selection of the grapes, as he is responsible of the Chardonnay expression in the respect of the House's know-how and style.

BOURGOGNE PINOT NOIR 2019

Our Pinot Noir grapes mainly come from selected terroirs on the Côte de Beaune and Côte Chalonnaise (in the South of Burgundy). A small part of our cuvée is also coming from the Côte de Nuits vineyards. Our viniculturist plays a very important part in selecting the grapes and vineyards, which will express the Pinot Noir at its best, in the respect of the House's know-how.

HERITAGE DU CONSEILLER CHARDONNAY



100% CHARDONNAY

Colour: bright straw-coloured

Nose: generous and seductive with notes of nectarine and acacia

Mouth: elegant, round and well-balanced with flavours of exotic fruits and a long finale It should be an elegant companion to mixed salads, grilled meats, fish and shellfish.

Vins de France are produced from different wine regions of France. This quite new appellation (2009) allows for a greater liberty in winemaking compared to the appellation system for you can blend varieties from different regions and vintages, plus choose the best technique to enhance them. It is a great opportunity for our winemaker to express his skills with a wine with a steady style and unique personality.

This wine perfectly reflects our commitment towards the enhancement of varieties, and more specifically Pinot Noir and Chardonnay.

BOUCHARD AINÉ

CHASSAGNE-MONTRACHET



BURGUNDY

Since 1750, Bouchard Aîné & Fils is devoted to the excellence and renown of the region's noble grapes. The 18th-century Hôtel du Conseiller du Roy in Beaune houses the cellars where is perpetuated, generation after generation, the tradition of quality, elegance and prestige in selecting and making fine Burgundy wines.

GEVREY-CHAMBERTIN



100% PINOT NOIR

Visual: A clear, brilliant cherry red.
Nose : Distinguished and complex, slightly woody, with hints of vanilla and red and black fruits (blackcurrants, raspberries and Morello cherries). Animal notes of musk and fur.
Palate: Full-bodied, with ageing potential, long and persistent. As the wine develops the presence of red fruits is confirmed, with a sub-structure of liquorice. Gevrey wines are noted for their strong character and intense, expressive aromas - powerful but extremely mellow.

The intense aromas of this Gevrey-Chambertin call for rich dishes such as a saddle of lamb, boeuf bourguignon or coq au vin, and ripe cheeses.

This famous appellation from the Côte de Nuits in Burgundy takes its name from the village of Gevrey-Chambertin. The famous area of Gevrey-Chambertin produces only red wines and extends over 406 hectares, 86 of which are classified as Premier Cru.

MEURSAULT



100% CHARDONNAY

Colour: Bright golden yellow with green tints.
Nose: Open, woody aromas accompanied by vanilla, toast, russet apples and hazelnuts.
Palate : Strong alcohol content with a woody quality and hints of vanilla. Round, smooth, velvety...
Ideal with blanquettes, poultry or fish in a cream sauce, Lyon saveloy in brioche...
One of the famous white Burgundy from the Côte de Beaune appellations which takes its name from the village of Meursault. The vineyards extends over 365 hectares with 95% given over to white wine and 25% classified as Premier Cru.

PINOT NOIR ROSÉ



100% PINOT NOIR

In accordance to our tradition and values of elegance and quality, the Pinot Noir grapes and juices from the South of France were selected on specific vineyards cultivated on clay and limestone soils along the Mediterranean coast. Subjected to strong thermal amplitude, the grapes benefit from very favorable conditions to come to full maturity and express all the richness of the variety.

BOUCHARD AINE/ CHATEAU CASTAGNAC

POMMARD



100% PINOT NOIR

Visual: A crystal, clear, cherry red.
Nose: Complex and powerful, predominantly fruity (Morello cherries, citrus fruits, fresh figs).
Oaky with scents of woodland undergrowth and spices.
Palate: Pommard wines are firm with a lot of colour and a vivid bouquet. Ours is powerful and robust with flavours of cherries, oak and spices, a very well-constituted structure and mellow tannins. A wonderfully well-balanced wine.
Ideal with roast game, grilled red meats, cheeses (especially cheeses ripened with a marc de Bourgogne).

POMMARD PREMIER CRU "LES CHARMOTS"



100% PINOT NOIR

Visual: Ruby red hue.
Nose: A nose redolent of black fruit and kirsch, finishing on a spicy note of cinnamon & clove.
Palate: The structure is soft and fleshy, with the same ripe fruit expressed on the palate. Well integrated oak contributes to the complexity of this wine.
Serve with furred game, bison steak, jugged hare, Burgundian cheeses such as Epoisses, Cîteaux or Langres.
The Terroirs of Bourgogne range is a selection of reputed single vineyards Villages, Premier and Grand Crus from Côte de Nuits and Côte de Beaune principally. They are produced in very limited quantities, as a sign of the special care we put into their production.
Pommard is one of the most famous villages in the Côte de Beaune, located 5 km south of Beaune on the Route des Grands Crus. The vineyard extends over 322 hectares and produces only red wines, with a proportion of 36% rated 1er Cru.

POUILLY-FUISSE 2019



100% CHARDONNAY

Colour: Brilliant and clear gold with green tints.
Nose: Elegant and mineral with flowery, vegetal undertones enlivened with a honey note.

CUVÉE JEAN-LOUIS ICE



NAPA VALLEY

Pale yellow color. Fine and elegant bubble stream. Expressive notes of candied fruit, white flowers and a hint of citrus on the nose. Supple and light on the palate, slightly sweet, both fresh and fruity, revealing white peach flavors. Cuvée Jean-Louis ICE Blanc de Blancs is much like the splendorous city of Paris: bustling, sparkling, decadent and perfect at any time, day or night. A pale pink color with fine and abundant bubbles. Fresh and fruity nose with aromas of ripe red berries. Appealing and seductive on the palate resulting from a balance between freshness and fruit, underscored by well adjusted dosage.

ALOXE-CORTON 1ER CRU "LES VALOZIÈRES"



CÔTE DE BEAUNE

Nearly half of the vineyard area is classified as Grand Cru and no less than 17 classified Premier Cru. There are two types: those located on the Pernand-Vergelesses side and for the one that interests us The Valozieres bordering the Grand Crus from below: the exhibition is perfect in the east, the land is quite heavy and deep giving wines a character structured and powerful.

Made from pinot noir grapes. The shiny color is garnet in color. This wine exudes elegant aromas of cherries and raspberries, with a floral and peppery touch. The palate, which combines density and delicacy, is marked by a beautiful freshness and a very good length.

BEAUNE 1ER CRU "LES GRÈVES"



PRIMIER CRU

The appellation is divided into two parts, north and south, which are separated by a division marked by the road that goes from Beaune up to Bouze-Les-Beaune.

In Old French, "Greves" referred to sandy soil that was well adapted to viticulture. The 30-hectare "Les Greves" vineyard is assuredly one of Beaune's best-known Premiers Crus. Seen from above, it forms a square block and occupies the entire length of the gentle, east-facing slope.

With a brilliant ruby color, this wine exudes very fine aromas of violets, small red fruits and cocoa notes. The tannins are coated on the palate, a wine with exceptional length and finesse.

LES URSULINES CHARDONNAY



BOURGOGNE

This 'vast' appellation brings together four great regions; Yonne to the north, with its fresh, mineral wines, followed by the Côte d'Or, with its rounder, deeper whites, the Côte Chalonnaise with its pleasant wines, and lastly the Mâcon region to the south, with a range of styles varying with the individual soil and exposure.

With a pale yellow color, this wine reveals all the richness of the vintage! Subtle woody aromas, white flowers, some citrus fruits. A good length in the mouth with a tangy finish!

LES URSULINES PINOT NOIR



BOURGOGNE

Pinot Noir is invariably associated with Burgundy and it is here that this varietal finds the conditions most conducive to its development. The Côte de Nuits and Côte de Beaune produce what are without doubt the greatest Pinot Noir wines in the world. For this sunny vintage, we have incorporated a supply from Yonne area into our blend to bring freshness!

With a pretty ruby color, this wine develops gourmet aromas of red and black berries with some peppery and subtly smoky notes. The palate is very well balanced. A wine full of juice, with a certain freshness that makes you salivate but also some fine tannins. A Burgundy of beautiful nobility!

ALIGOTE MOUTOTS



BOURGOGNE

This regional appellation may be cultivated throughout wine-growing Burgundy. The appellation covers a surface area of approximately 1,400 ha. Burgundy's soils are clay-limestone based, but variations between villages can have significant influence on the characteristics of the wines. This is why careful selection is essential for crafting the finest wines.

"Les Moutots" is specific "lieu-dit" located in the South of the village of Chorey-Les-Beaune.

With a beautiful golden yellow color, this Burgundy Aligote of character reveals very mineral aromas accompanied by lemony and floral notes. On the palate, this wine reveals a beautiful harmony on a tangy finish and a very good length. A wine that makes you salivate.

CHAMBOLLE-MUSIGNY



PRIMIER & GRAND CRU

Our cuvée is a blend of four "climats" of Chambolle-Musigny: "Les pas de chats", "Derrière le four", "Le Clos de L'Orme" and "Les Danguerrins". Wines made from grapes produced in organic managed vineyards since 2009 (but not certified).

With a beautiful ruby color, this wine surprises with its freshness. It reveals aromas of fresh red berries and intense dried flowers. In the second nose, we will find slightly peppery and toasted notes. The palate is silky and reveals remarkable length! It is a very "salivating" wine.

1ER CRU LES CHARMES 2019



CHAMBOLLE-MUSIGNY

This appellation is one of the smallest and most parceled out of the Côte with only 97 ha of Village appellation vines, 50 ha of Premiers Crus and 25 ha of Grand Crus. The terroirs of Chambolle-Musigny are rather homogenous and enjoy eastern exposure. The delicate silkiness of its wines stems directly from the soil type.

This term "Charmes" is used in Burgundy to designate poor vegetation plateaux, uncultivated or fallow land. Formerly there were many plots not worked by their owner because they were very stony and difficult to cultivate. The color is garnet red. The nose is very expressive with intense aromas of blueberries but also dried roses with subtly woody notes. Powerful, long in the mouth, its structure is concentrated with a finish of freshness.

CLOS DE LA ROCHE GRAND CRU 2019



BOURGOGNE

Nestled between Gevrey-Chambertin and Chambolle-Musigny, Morey-Saint-Denis produces five Grands Crus. Located at the north of the commune, Clos de la Roche takes its name from a boulder that the Celts used for their rituals. Lying adjacent to the Latricières-Chambertin vineyard, it produces Morey's most robust wines. This vineyard is difficult to work, with such stony soil that was considered to be a "backbreaker" by the growers of yesteryear. This hard, brown limestone soil yields very firm wines that are well-suited to aging.

With its beautiful dark ruby color, this wine develops on the first nose a very floral bouquet, characteristic of this Grand Cru, then a complex aromatic palate of ripe red fruits and intense spices. The palate, which is rather flexible, reveals a beautiful richness. This wine can be slightly tannic in its youth but will soften over the years.

JEAN CLAUDE BOISSET

GEVREY-CHAMBERTIN



CÔTE DE NUITS

This wine's name alone evokes prestige. Gevrey-Chambertin is one of the noblest places in Burgundy and marks the true beginning of Burgundy's Grands Crus... The vines are planted at altitudes of between 240 and 280 metres. The soil is limestone-based with a high proportion of clay marlstones from the scree of the Combe de Lavaux, giving power and roundness to the wines. The grapes for this wine came from several vineyards located north of the village on the famed Brochon which produces Gevrey's finest "Village" wines.

The color is a brilliant garnet red. With aromas of red berries, violet and some smoky notes. On the palate a dense mouth with acidulated frame that brings a lot of length.

GEVREY-CHAMBERTIN LES MUROTS



CÔTE DE NUITS

It boasts one of the largest surface areas under vines. The soil is limestone-based with a high proportion of clay marlstones from the scree of the Combe de Lavaux, giving power and roundness to the wines. "Les Murots" is located on the lower slope of the village of Gevrey-Chambertin, on a soil composed of very poor scree gravel. The yields are naturally very low (30-35hL / ha) and the berries are very concentrated each year.

The color is dark garnet. The nose exhales very fruity aromas, on black cherry, as well as peppery notes. On the palate, this delicious wine is silky. It is marked by a slightly peppery finish.

LADOIX 1ER CRU HAUTES MOUROTTE



MOUROTTE

Created in 1970, the appellation features 11 Premier Cru vineyards which benefit from eastern or south-east/southern exposure with altitudes varying between 230 and 325 m. The soils at the upper part of the slope are pebbly, reddish, limestone based with a high proportion of marls and considerable flint-limestone fragments. Les Hautes Mourottes is located just a few metres from the famous Corton-Renardes. In old local dialect, Mourottes referred to walls which would indicate that the vineyard was once surrounded by walls. Its garnet color has purple reflections. This wine reveals intense aromas of black fruits such as cherry in alcohol, mixed with some minty notes. The palate is dense and silky with a long finish.

MARANGES 1ER CRU LA FUSSIÈRE



CÔTE DE BEAUNE

Neighboring the Santenay appellation, the Maranges appellation is located on the southern tip of the Côte de Beaune. Mostly planted in Pinot Noir, the hills forming this vineyard has a south/south-east exposure, with an altitude oscillating between 240 and 400 meters. "La Fuisse", which extends over almost 35 hectares with a beautiful exposure to the south, has a mainly marly soil (gray and blue marls covered with calcareous scree). The name "Fuisse" is derived from the ancient French "Faisse" or "Faissa" which means "land strip". This refers to the terraced winegrowing we find on this steeply slope. With a beautiful dark red color with purple reflections, the nose exudes a very expressive bouquet of floral notes added with mineral touches. The palate is distinguished by its roundness, its structuring tannins and always this minerality. And a very long finish.

JEAN CLAUDE BOISSET

MARSANNAY BLANC



NEAR THE VILLAGE OF COUCHEY

With 27 ha of white grapes under vine and 147 ha of red, the white wines of Marsannay remain something of a curiosity. The vineyards are planted in clay-limestone soil dating back to the Middle Jurassic period. Located in the southern part of the appellation, near the village of Couchey, the vineyard's eastern exposure along with its small limestone pebbles and numerous faults allow for the production of elegant, pure wines. The 45-year-old vines are planted at an altitude of 230 m. This pale yellow wine with golden reflections, offers aromas of white flowers, yellow fruits and some spices on the nose. Its dense palate reveals a tangy finish.

MARSANNAY ROGUE



CÔTE DE NUITS

The vineyard of "The Golden Gate of the Côte de Nuits" covers the towns of Chenove, Marsannay-la-Côte and Couchey. This AOC is based on soils of great complexity of clay-limestone Middle Jurassic type. The grapes of this cuvée come exclusively from the climate "La Bretignière" located in the town of Couchey a few hundred meters from the Fixin appellation. This small plot is located at the bottom of the hill with a full-east exposure and on a predominantly limestone soil. There are traces of the name "La Bretignière" (from the old French Breton / Breton = hawk) in the 1700s, it refers to the presence of a falconry where birds of prey were raised for hunting. It was attached to a manor house. This Marsannay, with an intense ruby color, develops a bouquet of blueberries and strawberries, as well as some notes of sweet spices and subtly smoky notes. The palate is rich and powerful and reveals a salivating finish.

NUITS-SAINT-GEORGES "LES CARBONNIERES"



NUITS-SAINT-GEORGES

Famed the world over, Nuits-Saint-Georges has the original character of a true wine village but the size of a small town. The range of soils, exposure and locations here creates a great diversity of terroirs. The area is bisected by the valley of the Meuzin river, and the village itself. Les Charbonnières are located at the southern end of the village, where the altitude is a little lower than in the north. The soil consists mainly of marl, combined with sand and pebbles from the top of the slope. Grape maturity is always excellent here. The color is a brilliant ruby red. The nose on this wine is complex, composed of aromas of red fruits and mineral notes with some violet aromas. The palate has a silky mouth with velvety tannins in attack and more structure in the final with some toasted notes.

SAINT-AUBIN 1^{ER} CRU EN REMILLY



EN REMILLY

The vines are mainly planted on the right flank of the broad combe which meanders towards La Rochepot. The appellation area is spread over two different massifs: one, the Montagne de Savoie, which ends the Côte d'Or and the other with the mountain of Ban which is perpendicular. The plot 'En Remilly' is located on the second slope and adjoins the largest names of the golden triangle. This climate is located a few meters from the Montrachet, facing south with a good stony ground. It is recognized as the best premier cru of the appellation with « Murgers des dents de chien ». The color is brilliant yellow with golden reflections. The complex nose will seduce you with its aromas of yellow fruits and pears, associated with notes of white flowers. On the palate, the wine is very generous, combining roundness and intensity. We detect some woody flavors.

JEAN CLAUDE BOISSET

SAINT-AUBIN 1ER CRU SUR GAMAY



SUR GAMAY

The appellation area is spread over two different massifs: one, the Montagne de Savoie, which ends the Côte d'Or and the other with the mountain of Ban which is perpendicular. This second slope houses the climate "Sur Gamay", located near the appellation of Puligny-Montrachet. The slope is strong and the vine is oriented to the east. The climate is called "Gamay", causing some confusion with the variety of the same name, because the plot is located above the hamlet called Gamay (part of Saint-Aubin).

The color is golden yellow.

The racy nose will seduce you with its delicate aromas of white flowers and pears associated with some mineral notes. On the palate, the wine is well balanced and elegant, revealing some honeyed flavors and a very nice tangy finish.

VOSNE ROMANEE LES JACQUINES



CÔTE DE NUITS

The village is located at the heart of the Côte de Nuits, between Vougeot and Nuits-Saint-Georges. The vines grow at an ideal altitude of approximately 250 metres and cover just over 150 ha. "Les Jacquines" is located south of the appellation, Nuits-Saint-Georges side, and this is the name of a land that has certainly belonged to Mr Jacquinot de Richemont, a member of Parliament from Dijon who, as far as we know, was a big land owner in the lieux-dits neighbouring "La Tâche".

The color is dark ruby red. The first nose is very spicy then reveal small red fruits. On the palate, there are frank and bright aromas. This wine is powerful with a fairly dense mouth and velvety tannins. A wine that makes you salivate.

AUBRY BRUT



***55% PINOT MEUNIER / 25%
CHARDONNAY / 20% PINOT NOIR
/ 5% ARBANNE, PETIT MESLIER
AD FROMENTEAU***

This complex and traditional Brut comes from the Jouy-les-Reims 1er Cru and Villedommange 1er Cru region. The Chardonnay is aged in stainless steel for a minimum of 24 months. Meunier expresses here as barley, rusks, crackers and so the wine is rusky, coppery-saline, iodé, mineral and appetizing. It's beautifully expressive of a corner of Champagne, and tastes as though it were fined with sea gris.

THE CHARD PROJECT



STA. RITA & CENTRAL COAST

Harvested from high quality vineyards in the Sta. Rita Hills and Central Coast of California. After the grapes are sorted and pressed, the juice is fermented in stainless steel tanks. The final assemblage is aged in 2-4 year old French barrels for 6 months to add texture with a hint of oak. After being bottled, the wine rests for three months before its release.

Shimmering yellow-gold in color. With first pour, find aromas of apple blossom, stone fruit, and lemon tart. This Chardonnay is driven by harmony, a balance of acidity, structure, and rich texture.

ROSÉ - FRANCE



IMPACT HOT PROSPECT AWARD WINNER

The grapes for this rosé of Pinot Noir come from the South of France, home to the finest rosés in the world. The grapes are gently pressed and the juice remains on the skins just long enough to give the wine its pale pink hue. The rosé is vinified in stainless steel to preserve its mineral core and juicy freshness.

Elegant pale pink in color. On the nose, a floral and fruity bouquet of raspberries and rose petals. A harmonious wine with dry, crisp acidity and good structure. Lively on the palate and a long, seamless finish.

PINOT NOIR



SONOMA, MONTEREY & CENTRAL COAST GRAPES

The Pinot Project Pinot Noir is handcrafted from high quality vineyards in California. The diversity in soil and climate from these AVAs contributes to depth in character, balance, and pristine fruit. The grapes are harvested at optimal ripeness and then destemmed in order to express bright fruit flavors and maintain freshness. The wine is fermented in stainless steel, and 20% of the blend is aged for 5 months in French oak.

Cool garnet in color with aromas of pomegranate and fresh roses, The Pinot Project Pinot Noir is balanced on the palate with notes of black cherry and five-spice and a smooth, lingering finish.

PINOT GRIGIO



POWERFUL AND RICH

Harvested from the prestigious growing region of Veneto, Italy. After the grapes are crushed and skins are removed, the grape must settles and temperature controlled fermentation occurs in stainless steel. The wine is completely unoaked to maintain freshness. After being bottled, it rests for five months before release.

Pale yellow in color with tinges of legume green. On the nose, pleasant aromas of white flowers, apricots, and pears. A pleasant and crisp wine with balanced acidity and good structure. Fresh, zippy, and persistent on the palate and finishes seamlessly.

BENCH CHARDONNAY



RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY

Glimmering honey colored in the glass, a delicate nose of apple blossoms, lemon candy and pie crust are immediately apparent. Mouth-filling and well textured. Bright acidity and minerality reveal flavors of salty almond streusel and baked pear followed by a long, seamless finish

BENCH PINOT NOIR



SONOMA COAST

Bench Pinot Noir is deep ruby red in the glass, the nose is full of dark berry fruit, hints of rose petals and baking spices. The texture is silky and richly opulent with black cherry, ripe fig and cedar wood rounding out a long, seamless finish.

BENCH CABERNET SAUVIGNON



KNIGHTS VALLEY

Deep purple in the glass, the nose opens with dark earth tones reminiscent of forest fruit, cocoa, and crushed rock. The palate is broad with fine, elegant tannins followed by flavors of blackberry, cherry, pastry crust and a hint of coffee bean.

SONOMA COUNTY

A California Merlot from Nights Valley. A medium to bold smooth wine that is soft and dry. Oaky notes with hints of black fruit. An elegant, food friendly wine.

GENERATIONS CABERNET



RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY

The grapes for this 2018 Generations Cabernet were grown in four vineyards in Napa Valley including the west side of St. Helena and Rutherford. The St. Helena vineyards provide fresh, concentrated and nicely textured fruit while the Rutherford grapes add structure and power to the overall wine. By blending grapes from these renowned vineyards and appellations, we are able to make a wine that truly represents the best of Napa Cabs and honors our five generations of making wine in the Napa Valley.

A beautiful deep purple color, it opens with wafting aromas of chocolate, sweet tobacco, spice cake and blackberry preserves. Full-bodied with rich and concentrated dark fruit flavors, this wine is layered with notes of juicy strawberry and raspberry and hints of oolong tea. Perfectly balanced with velvety tannins, the finish is long, fresh and fragrant.

Over the next several years, they transformed the destination into a grocery store for the Napa.

Today, the historic family home stands at the gateway of one of the unsurpassed wine regions of the world and the home is one of the finest homes from the era.

Harvested in the cool morning hours from vineyards across Napa Valley including the Calistoga, St. Helena and Rutherford appellations, the grapes were hand sorted and underwent extended maceration before aging for 10 months in 25% new French oak.

A dark purple in the glass opening with vibrant aromas of red cherry, strawberry and mulberry with a suggestion of lilac. The flavors are layered with baked plum, blueberries and mocha with a nuance of spice and a touch of earthiness on the palate. This is a structured and well-balanced Cabernet Sauvignon with fine-grained tannins and a textured finish that lingers.

TEXTURES DE PEDRA

Maximum expression of the Mediterranean varieties, the Penedès climate and a stony soil, and the result of long ageing on the lees.
Textures de Pedra is named after its vineyard of origin, the Vinya Més Alta, situated at the top of the Turó del Serral, the highest point on our estate, where the soils are stony. The geology of these plots means that the vines' roots have to reach down to deeper layers in order to find water (the soil is fresher), and this produces grapes that favour the creation of more concentrated wines, with more structure.

DE LA FINCA

De la Finca sparkling wine is made with grapes from our oldest vines, planted using the gobelet system in 1964 in the Vinya dels Fòssils. Native variety that is planted on 50% of the entire estate. It is our seal of identity, the variety that allows the long ageing of our sparkling wines, due to its good agricultural performance and its aromatic and taste potential.

The vines of the Barbera, Plana and Viader plots have deep soil with a clay loam texture, which provides us with freshness and elegance. The Monestrell plot, situated on the terraces on Serral hill, marks the De Nit sparkling wine with its personality.

Blanc de Blancs is a sparkling wine marked by the typicity of its place of origin, the Vinya del Llac, a vineyard over 40 years' old, which allows us to obtain a structured, fresh and complex sparkling wine.

FINCA RESALSO



PESQUERA DE DUERO

We see the third generation, the four sibling. Ever since they were small they helped their father Emilio Moro in all manner of viticulture tasks, and in that way they began to love the world of winemaking and all that it entailed.

This wine originates from a selection of our medium-aged vineyards representing our most important soil types, which is why this wine reflects a great variety of aromatic nuances and taste sensations, notes that are both complex and harmonious, partly due to its 12 months of barrel aging. The successful combination of the different oak varieties and toasts is a direct consequence of the profound knowledge that the Moro family has with regard to its wines, using barrels types that over the years have demonstrated their ability to give Emilio Moro finesse, elegance and smoothness through their integration with the wine, which is the true protagonist in the ensemble.

MALLEOLUS



PESQUERA DE DUERO

We see Emilio Moro racking wine in the traditional fashion in the old wine cellar. Malleolus in Latin and Majuelo in Spanish is the fundamental word in the elaboration of this wine, the old vine which still maintains a character inherited from past centuries, with personality, elegance and exclusivity. It is the essence of our oldest vineyards that is the key to understanding this Malleolus, which, through its grape variety matured for 18 months in new French oak, intensely expresses balsamic aromas, spices and tobacco contributed from the oak, naturally enriching the grand ensemble. Aromas of ripe, black fruits are still present throughout the tasting and clearly indicate the raw material wherein lies the richness and exclusivity of this wine.

MALLEOLUS DE VALDERRAMIRO



PESQUERA DE DUERO

We observe Emilio Moro pruning in one of the family's vineyards. Recovering the essence of the vineyards (majuelos), we take the concept of terroir to its maximum expression, using grapes from our oldest vines. In this wine we concentrate the minerality obtained from the deep roots of near one hundred year-old vines that have managed to explore the layers of clay soils in the vineyard.

The varieties dominate the tasting with persistence and warmth, and a simple expression of mature black fruit that lead in part to sweet, liquor notes. The blend of barrels selected for this wine is the result of three generations of knowledge gained from working this parcel and the wines it produces. Malolactic fermentation in American oak and aging for 18 months in French oak provides a perfect ensemble with the intense aromas and unctuousness from the clay in this unique parcel.

EMILIO MORO

TEMPRANILLO



PESQUERA DE DUERO
The alma mater of the winery, without doubt the best photo to represent this wine is that of the first and second generation. It shows the young Emilio Moro harvesting with his father, also called Emilio, in one of the family's first vineyards.

MALLEOLUS DE SANCHOMARTIN



PESQUERA DE DUERO
We observe Emilio Moro in the barrel aging area of the winery, presenting the result of one of the first vintages. A photo that is particularly cherished by the family. The combination of altitude, exposure and soil in the Sanchomartín vineyard mean that the wine produced from its grapes is unique. The elegance and finesse of the chalk find their peak in this glass of wine, with the floral notes, balsamic and spicy aromas of French oak, all giving the wine a richness and unique expressivity. The evolution in the glass gives us an idea of the depth and richness of the registers in the ensemble, with subtleness and sweetness as the keys to this wine, that invites and entices us to discover more. The finish leaves us with an ensemble of warm aromas reverberating around our palette, provoking a sensation that impels us to take another sip.

LA FELISA



PESQUERA DE DUERO
The year is 1957, Felisa and Emilio Moro on their honeymoon at Villamartín de Campos. At first it highlights the density of color, a very deep layer and a ripe cherry red color very bright. In the nose dominate the aromas of fine red wine in its purest and primary version, with hints of black fruits, violet and licorice. There are also pastry notes such as toffee and vanilla. In the mouth it is intense, with a marked but mature tannin and a long aftertaste.

EL ZARZAL



PESQUERA DE DUERO
The color is pale golden, clean and bright. The nose is clean and highlights a stone fruit base, subtle citrus aromas and white flowers. The light toasted notes add complexity to the aromatic profile of the wine. In the palate it is fresh and bright, with good weight and polished nuances.

EMILIO MORO/BODEGAS OLARRA/MONTE ANTICO

LA RAVELIA



PESQUERA DE DUERO

With a pale golden color the wine is presented with very intense aromas, full of nuances, where the varieties of Godello stand out like fresh stone fruits and subtle citrus and herbaceous. Once it develops, we can appreciate the great aromatic potential of this wine, the fruity aromas gain complexity and show hints of dried flowers and light toasted. In the palate is broad and well structured, with a long and balanced acidity.

BODEGAS OLARRA RED BLEND RIOJA CERRO ANNON RESERVA



PESQUERA DE DUERO

At the time of release, this wine showed a bright crimson red colour. On the nose, aromas of sweet ripe fruit and delicate notes of smokiness. On the palate, tastes of cherry, plum and blackberries combined with gentle clean aromas of oak. Elegant mouthfeel, a full body and a fresh and fruity aftertaste. This wine still has plenty of life in it and should drink very well for the next 10-15 years.

MONTE ANTICO



85% SANGIOVESE, 10% CABERNET SAUVIGNON, AND 5% MERLOT

Deep ruby colour with garnet reflections, its elegant bouquet of leather, black cherries, liquorice and plums preludes a medium to full-bodied palate where ripe red fruit, subtle notes of vanilla and violets harmonize and linger, interlacing with the soft tannins and silky texture. Perfect integration of acidity and fruit, medium finish.

BARBERA D'ALBA DOC CIABOT CAMERANO



LA MORRA & NEVIGLIE

Its intense garnet color, clarity, and warm ruby-red reflections are indications of its extraordinary richness and powerful structure. The full bouquet is characteristic, complex and very persistent, the palate austere and warm, and its considerable full body accentuated; the wine's superb balance and harmony are further exalted by sweet tannins. This wine is perfectly accompanied by important traditional meat dishes: it is optimal with braised beef, game and aged cheese.

BAROLO BRUNATE DOCG



LA MORRA & BAROLO

Barolo is without a doubt the noblest creation of the nebbiolo grape, and in Marcarini's "Brunate" selection it finds one of its highest quality expressions. For several generations, our family has owned a considerable part of the Brunate vineyards; Brunate has been recognized as one of the Langhe's most important cru zones since the 1300s, and today is officially recognized as a Menzione Geografica Aggiuntiva. Overall, it is subject only to traditional winemaking techniques. Barolo Brunate has a magnificent garnet-red color with intense ruby-red reflections, of correct intensity and tonality. The nose is composite, rich, full and persistent, with hints of balsamic, menthol, sweet spices, tobacco, mountain hay and underbrush. Impressive taste sensations reveal the wine's imperious, noble, warm and velvety character, and the flavor is long and intense.

BAROLO CHINATO



BAROLO

A splendid, unique digestive and dessert wine, the Barolo Chinato traces its origins to the heart of the Barolo region toward the end of the 1800s. It derives from an ancient recipe that has been carefully preserved by our ancestors: the infusion of China Calissaya bark and several aromatic alpine herbs with aged Barolo wine has long been considered a remedy for several diseases.

Aged for a long time in oak barrels, this aromatic wine becomes a low alcohol "elixir," amber-colored and with ruby-red reflections. Its spicy, intense and persistent nose and the bittersweet taste of the China bark make it a lovely and inviting wine. A rare specialty for connoisseurs!

There are various excellent ways to serve Barolo Chinato Marcarini: mixed with mineral water and ice, as an aperitif; neat, as a delicate after-dinner liqueur; or warmed up and served with orange peel, when it becomes the ideal drink for frosty winter evenings. Not just a meditation wine, Barolo Chinato is a fantastic companion with dark chocolate desserts.

DOLCETTO D'ALBA DOC - FONTANAZZA



LA MORRA

"Fontanazza" presents a magnificent ruby-red color with lovely violet reflections. The intense and persistent nose offers floral and fruity sensations with evident signs of sweet spices. The palate is characterized by the same sensations, exalted by a pleasant acidity and a delicate, slightly bitter aftertaste. With its characteristics, the Dolcetto "Fontanazza" is an excellent companion to every dish of Italian and international cuisines.

ANDELUNA 1300



MALBEC - MENDOZA, AR

The grapes for this wine are carefully hand-selected from vineyards located at 1300m ASL in the Uco Valley of Mendoza. After maceration, fermentation is started with natural and selected yeasts and takes place in temperature-controlled stainless steel tanks. The wine then ages in French oak barrels for a period of 3 months and then in bottle for a minimum of 3 months.

Intense bright and purple in color. Floral violet notes in the beginning and a very intense fresh fruity expression, reminding of red plum, strawberry and blackberry. Fresh, smooth and balanced in the mouth, with a subtle mineral texture.

For the first time the Faithful Hound blend has Merlot as the lead variety, just a few percent more than Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc.
